When the Italian Government signed the treaty of peace, did it do so with mental eservations that it would give religious liberty to people, the ones they liked, nd would withhold theright of worship to those whom they did not like provided 1422 F hat they were not Pentecostals, those of the Church of Christ, Baptists, Methodists C. nd other minorities. I think that Italy surrendered unconditionally and the treaty of 7811 f peace only had no reservations.

Article 15 of the Peace Treaty specifically provides for the protection of reigious minorities. It does not say Pentecostals, Baptists or anything else and he Italian Government agreed to this as a rolemn covenant. Did it mean this, or id it not? This is all we want to know. With these facts before you, Sir, we now that our government will take whatever measures are necessary to bring about he application of the law for full liberty under the guidance of God. For we wish on the Italian Government and Italian people God's richest blessing.
